

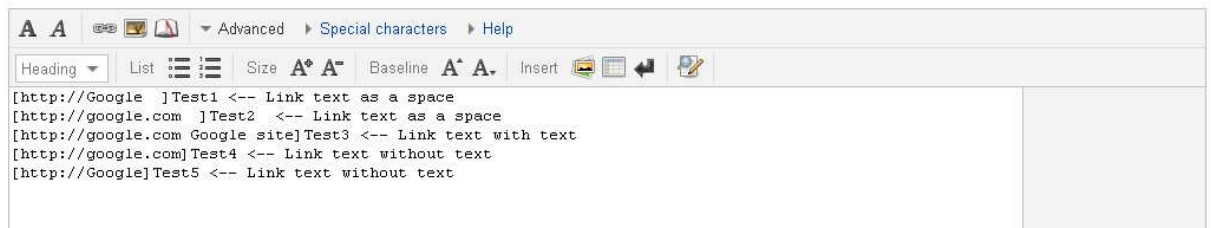
- 1) Select a random page
- 2) Edit a section
- 3) Click link to add a link
- 4) Select "To an external web page"
- 5) Enter the text in page title. Example: Google
  - << "To a wiki page" option is getting selected>>
  - <<If the user enter ".com ", "To an external web page" option is selected>>
- 6) Enter a space in "Link text" section
- 7) Click on "Insert link"
- 8) Press enter in and add another link
- 9) Click on Preview
  - <<All the links are in one line even the lines are braked by enter>>
