

How are mismatches found?

The Mismatch Finder shows you the origin of each mismatch in the results table. The mismatches come from a variety of sources, notably:

- Researchers that are analyzing Wikidata's data;
- Large reusers of Wikidata's data;
- Individual contributors working with Wikidata's data;

How fresh are the mismatches?

It depends! Inspecting external databases, catalogs and websites takes a lot of time and resources; the checks are performed periodically in batches. We try hard to remove outdated mismatches, but you might still find some.

How can I contribute new mismatches?

If you've compared Wikidata's data against an external data source and have found mismatches, you can:
