==Motto and arms==
The motto of the University was "**Arduus ad solem**", meaning "striving towards the sun". It is a metaphor for aspiring to [[Enlightenment (concept)|enlightenment]]. It is a quote from [[Virgil]]'s [[Aeneid]] book VI, and the archives do not record the reasons for its choice<ref>Thompson, Joseph (1886). The Owens College - its foundation and growth. Manchester: J. E. Cornish</ref>. The original verse refers to a serpent and the sun, both of which featured in the university [[coat of arms]]. The serpent is traditionally associated with wisdom. The arms were granted in October 1871 to Owens College while the Victoria University had arms of its own which fell into abeyance from 1904 upon the merger of the College with the University.

The emblem of the University in use for a number of years (last used September 2004) was based on the archway into the quadrangle from Oxford Road where there used to be a set of coats of arms relating to the history of the component colleges on the gates.
