</p><p><p><p>Research [[scientist]]s are the primary audience for the journal, but summaries and accompanying articles make many of the
most important papers understandable for the general public and to scientists in other fields. Toward the front of each issue are
[[editorial]]s, news and feature articles on issues of general interest to scientists, including current affairs, science funding,
business, scientific [[ethics]] and research breakthroughs. There are also sections on books and arts. The remainder of the journal
consists mostly of research articles, which are often dense and highly technical. Due to strict limits on the length of articles, in
many cases the printed text is actually a summary of the work in question with many details relegated to accompanying ''supplementary
material'' on the journal's website.</p><p></p><p>In 2007 ''Nature'' (together with ''[[Science (journal)|Science]]'') received the
[[Prince of Asturias Awards|Prince of Asturias Award]] for Communications and
